The new campus construction is moving along! Our soon to be warm and nurturing state-of-the-art campus will provide the perfect setting for our students to thrive. Full demolition of the 163,000 sq. ft. interior of the building is complete

Framing of all the key components has begun, including classrooms, offices, learning spaces and more

Groundwork for the addition of our 15,000 sq. ft. gym has commenced

Crews have started the conversion process of the existing parking lot to its future use as our athletic fields

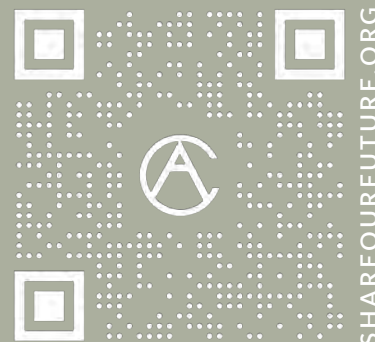
SHARE OUR FUTURE CAMPAIGN
